### **Overall Purpose of the Job:**

The purpose of this role is to hand assemble mechanical parts, function test PCBs, and then assemble together. Pack the parts accordingly to set specifications, paying particular attention to workmanship quality and health and safety issues and ensuring mistakes are minimised and production targets are met.

- No experience required. Minimum 5 GSCE's (C Grade or higher) or equivalent;
- Must maintain a professional culture at all times;
- Commitment to quality and excellence in workmanship standards;
- Must have the ability to perform in a fast changing, high-pressured environment and work to challenging and changing deadlines;
- Pride in work - consistency, accuracy and attention to detail;
- Must have excellent communication skills;

### **Principal Responsibilities:**

- Kitting of Parts;
- Accurate hand assembly of mechanical and electronic assemblies;
- Ensuring production targets are met;
- Good housekeeping at all times;
- Other duties may be included in this role but which will be consistent with the role;
